TOWN OF PAWLEYS ISLAND
PAWLEYS ISLAND SOUTH CAROLINA
August 9, 2004

WHEREAS, The Town of Pawleys Island is dedicated to it's unique heritage of gentleness, tranquility and history for the benefit of it's residents, property owners and visitors; and

WHEREAS, The design and color of residences on the Island has historically been low key and muted including variety which has been generally consistent with the low country "laid back" heritage of Pawleys Island; and

WHEREAS; there have recently been concerns voiced by residents and property owners that there have been recent instances of design and color which, if continued, could change the style of the Island, and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission of the Town has considered mandatory standards and has expressed support for the Pawleys style of construction, but also expressed reservations about additional regulations unless they become required;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Council of Pawleys Island, South Carolina requests that property owners considering construction, alteration or changes in colors or materials on their homes use the Commissions letter of August 10, 2004 as voluntary guideline. Each owner can help preserve the Islands architectural heritage, continue to be "good neighbors" and eliminate the need for future regulation on others.

This resolution approved this ninth day of August, 2004.


